

Attach the top of one form to the bag/box containing the food in so the pantry will know it came from an FFF donation. Keep the bottom half for tax your records.

Make a photocopy of the form: place one copy in the FFF food collection box at your office and keep the second for your tax records. Lastly, please also send a scan/photocopy to [Jshared@AmpleHarvest.org](mailto:Jshared@AmpleHarvest.org) or fax it to 866-748-3516.

**Note:** Consult with your tax advisor concerning the deductibility of your food donations for federal and state taxes.
